## We're a place for retail knowledge

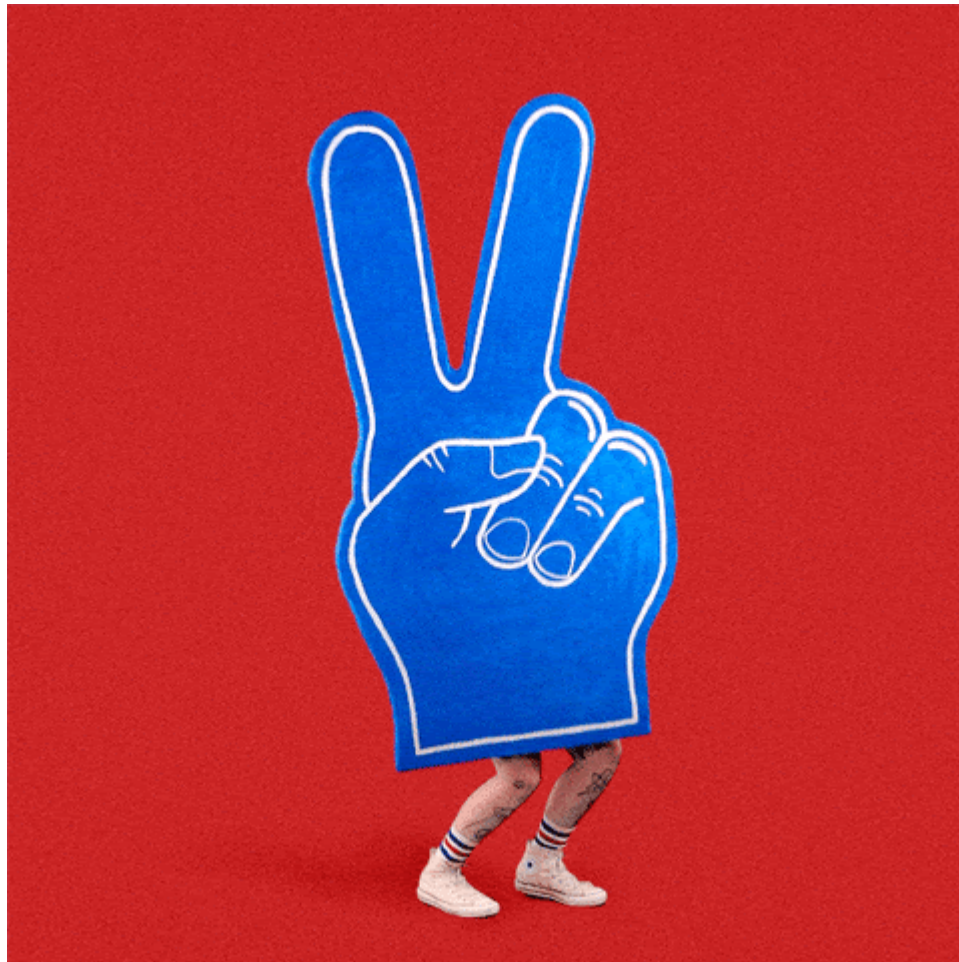
