

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

You must have submitted your 2023-24 Housing Application in eRezlife before Feb. 18th and paid your housing deposit by March 1st, 2023 to participate in the Housing Lottery.

Additional Information on Housing Deposits

- You must pay your housing deposit by March 1st, 2023 via Self-Service.
- If you are waitlisted and do not receive an assignment OR if you decide to cancel your assignment prior to June 1st 2023, your \$250 deposit will get applied to your student account.
- If you do receive a housing assignment but cancel it after June 1st 2023, your deposit will NOT be refunded.
- If you are unable to pay your \$250 housing deposit you will be unable to participate in the housing lottery and could be waitlisted.



CCAD HOUSING LOTTERY REVIEW

The 2023-24 Housing Lottery will take place Thursday, March 2, 2023. Each student who completes a housing application and pays their housing deposit will be provided a 15-minute lottery window in which to select a room assignment until all available spaces are occupied.


Additional Information about The Housing Lottery

- You must access the lottery within your provided 15minute interval
- When your time slot opens, you may select a bed space for yourself
- If you are in a roommate group the person with the earliest selection time can choose for the roommate group



CREATING ROOMMATE PROFILE

1. Select the 'My Roommate Profile' tab



- 2. Provide any information you'd like to share with potential roommates
- 3. Determine who can see your profile information
- 4. Turn profile on and save

Please fill out the following profile information. This information will be used to help connect you with the possible roommates. Only those students who have completed an application form will be able to view this information.


Turn on my profile

This will make your profile viewable by other applicants. If you disable it, applicants will not be able to see you and you will not be able to see them. If you disable it, your contacts will still be able to view your profile.

- 3. Send contact requests




4. Once accepted, you can add contacts to your roommate groups

- All groups will be listed under the 'Roommate Groups' tab like below.




Select which group you'd like to room with



SELECTING ROOMMATE GROUPS

1. Go to 'Roommate Groups'



2. Be sure to check your preferred group



- Only roommates who have selected the same group (shown with a check mark) will be grouped together for lottery selection. Failure to select a specific group may result in different placement
- Members must be part of the same group in order to select bed spaces for other roommate(s)

Before agreeing to be in a roommate group, we encourage you to discuss the following:


- When are your lottery time slots?

- Are there other groups you might be interested in joining?
- Any other questions or concerns about living habits and/or arrangements

SELECTING HOUSING


- 1. Go to "Housing Applications"

- 5. Select your bed space during your lottery window




DSA FLOORPLANS



Design Square Apartments will be the only residence hall open for selection during the housing lottery. Not every space within DSA will be available for selection during the lottery.



DSA FLOORPLANS



Standard 4-bedroom

Bedroom: 11 ft. 7 in. x 9 ft. 2 in.

Floor to Ceilings: 8 ft.

- Each bedroom will house 1 student and the expectation is that no more than 2 students share a bathroom
- Students in bed spaces A&C will share a bathroom, while bed spaces B&D share
- The bed closest to the entrance is bed space A.
- Odd-numbered apartments face the campus quad, while even-numbered apartments face downtown Columbus.



FAQS

1. What if I'm having issues with lottery during my selection time?

2. Do I need to make a roommate profile or a roommate group?

No, only if you want to choose who you are living with next fall

3. What if I miss my time slot?

You will be bumped from the line and could be waitlisted.

4. What it I want to live in Schottenstein?

Schottenstein is held for incoming first year students. If space permits, returning students on the waitlist can be offered a bed space in Schottenstein sometime mid to late summer.
