

SINGLE SEMESTER INDEPENDENT STUDY

Independent Study provides students with the opportunity to pursue in-depth scholarly research and self-direct learning, as well as uniting their regular degree requirements with their personal interests. All Independent Study applications should propose a project or area of study that will allow the student to explore their academic and career interests in greater depth and with a focus that goes beyond class time or beyond current course offerings. As such, an Independent Study cannot be in lieu of a required course within a program of study without express written permission from the appropriate School Dean.

IMPORTANT CCAD POLICY NOTES --- PLEASEREAD CAREFULLY:

Commitment: it is a privilege, not a right, to participate in Independent Studies, Incomplete or insufficient applications will be rejected.

Supervision: The student should develop their proposed Independent Study with a Faculty Advisor (a CCAD faculty member approved by their Program Chair). All students should be aware that no faculty member may supervise more than one student for an Independent Study during any given semester.

Application Deadline: All applications must be complete, approved, and registered no later than five (5) business days before the beginning of term. No retroactive credits for Independent Study will be given.

Commitment: The nature of Independent Study is that it must exceed that which is available in the normal program curriculum. Students should work with their Faculty Advisor to articulate study and research that will allow exploration of studio and career interests in greater depth and with a focus that goes beyond class time or beyond current course offerings; it is required for the student and Faculty Advisor to provide 3-4 clear learning outcomes and goals for the proposed independent study in this form.

Limitations: Students are limited to no more than three (3) credit hours of Independent Study in one semester, and no more than a total of six (6) credit hours in a CCAD program of study.

Grading: Final grades for Independent Study are graded by the Faculty Advisor as they would be for any normal course.
