For reference, the following are CCAD's requirements for a student to earn credit:

- The internship experience spans the duration of a full semester (12–16 weeks).
- The internship includes at least 240 on-site work hours completed during the semester. No “virtual” experiences. (Average of 15 hours per week during the academic year, 20 hours per week during the summer).
- The work is directly related to the student's major area of study.
- There is a supervisor to guide the student throughout the entire internship.
- The supervisor is an industry professional within the student's major area of study.
- The supervisor and student outline and define learning objectives to complete within the internship.
- The supervisor agrees to and completes an end-term evaluation on the student.

[2D, 3D, experimental, and motion graphics; program knowledge includes Storyboard Pro, ToonBoom, Harmony, Aftereffects, Sketchup, Maya, Zbrush; Adobe Flash, Illustrator, Photoshop]
- Film and Video**
[Skilled in every step of the filmmaking process—storyboarding, production design, producing, directing, cinematography, sound design, editing, and other post-production disciplines. Cinematic Arts related production software includes Storyboard Pro, Movie Magic Scheduling, Movie Magic Budgeting, Premiere Pro, Final Cut Pro, Soundtrack Pro, After Effects, and Photoshop.]

[An array of skills in ceramics, drawing, glassblowing, painting, printmaking, jewelry, and sculpture; knowledge includes Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, InDesign]
- Illustration**
[Technical, conceptual, and entrepreneurial skills, works collaboratively with other fields; knowledge includes Illustrator, InDesign, Photoshop, Zbrush, Storyboard Pro; editorial illustration, graphic novels, concept art, toy design, etc.]
- Industrial Design**
[Research, analyze, empathize, define, conceptualize, model, validate, and address complex design issues in a global market; knowledge includes qualitative and quantitative research, sketching, Solidworks (CAD), prototyping (3D printing, laser cutter, CNC, etc.); consumer & industrial products, furniture, soft goods (shoes, bags, etc.), toys, packaging, displays, exhibits.]
- Interior Design**
[Hand sketching, computer modeling, and communication in order to implement interiors for major architectural, hospitality, and retail firms; knowledge includes Auto CAD]
- Photography**
[Versed in commercial and fine art photography practices, skills including digital and traditional photographic tools, problem solving and teamwork; knowledge in lighting, retouch, camera work, Adobe Creative Suite, and Capture One]
