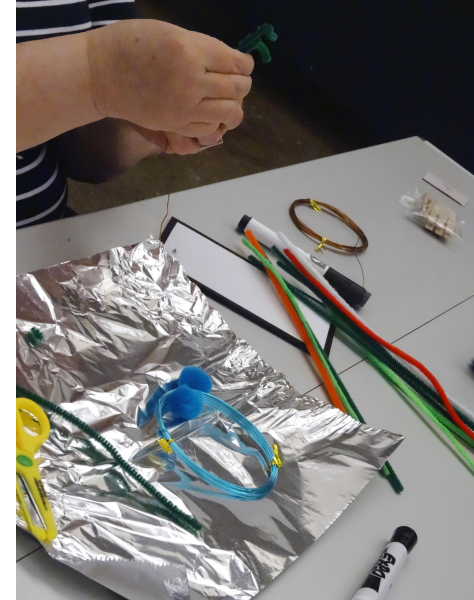

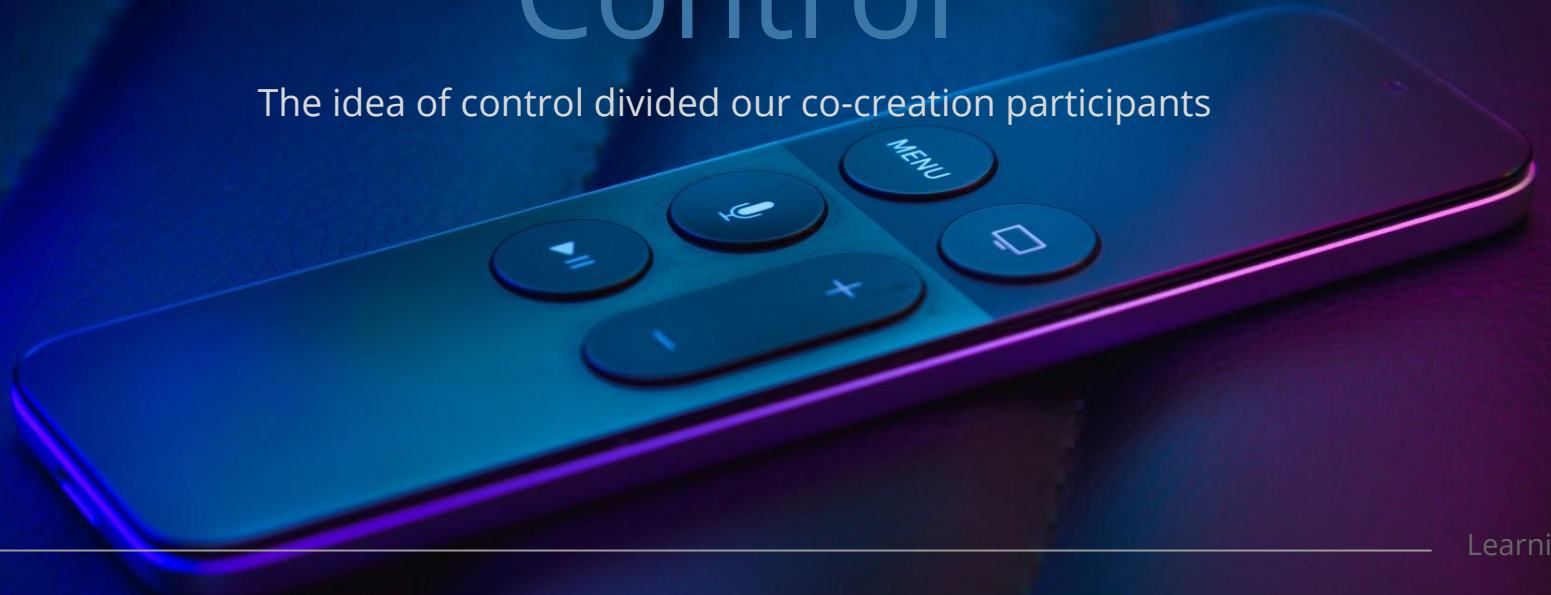

The idea of control divided our co-creation participants



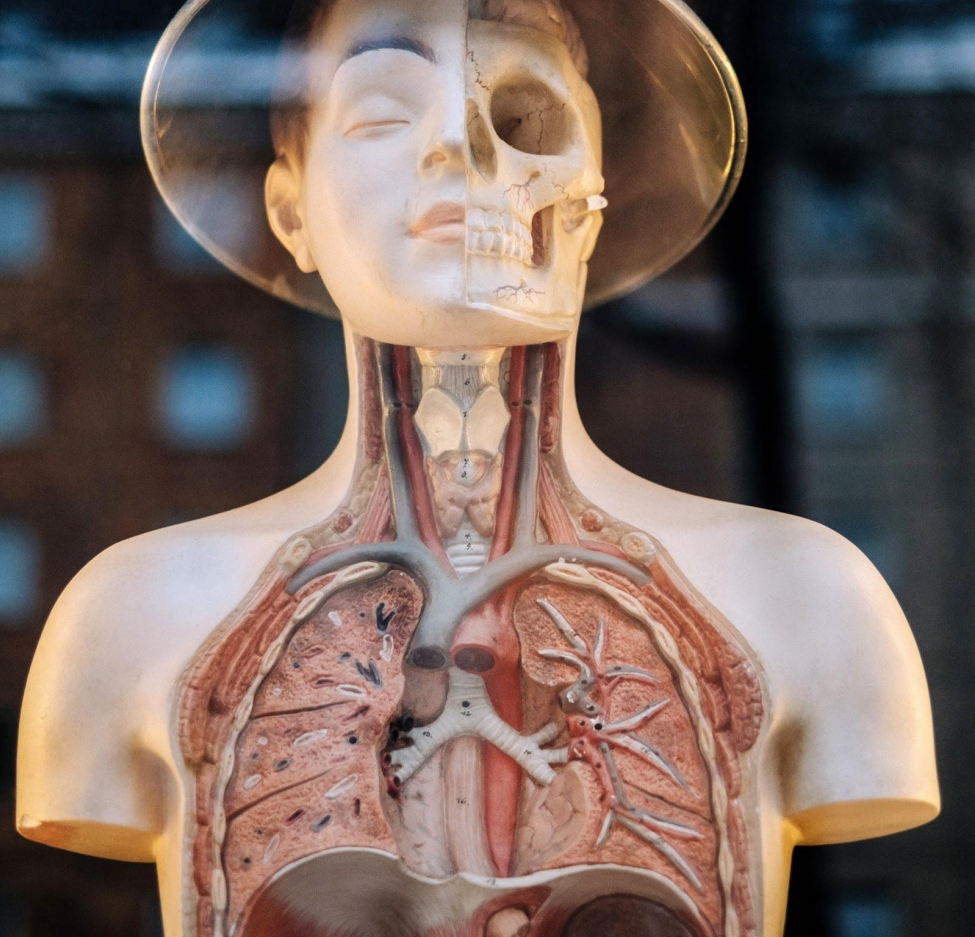


In a future where the digital world acts as its own smart city, how will we maintain citizenship between the digital and physical spaces?
